Official Rules 2024 Last Mountain Fall Walleye Classic

1. Eligibility

A) All persons 16 years of age or older are eligible to enter the Last Mountain Fall Walleye Classic tournament. Anglers under 16 must fish with a parent or guardian.

2. Requirements

- A) Each contestant must have in their possession a valid Saskatchewan fishing license.
- B) Promoters and organizations assisting in the tournament operation, their agencies, and agents, are not responsible for death, injury, damage, liability, theft, fire or any loss to any entrants. Each entrant, upon signing an accepted entry form, will in effect be signing a waiver form.
- C) Each entrant will be required to have a US Coast Guard or Canadian approved personal flotation device(PFD).
- D) One team member must attend the rules meeting.

3. Boats and Equipment

- A) All boats will be required to meet Canadian regulations and must have valid liability insurance in place.
- B) All boats will be required to carry a provincial or state registration in accordance with the regulations of the home province or state of the contestant owning the boat.
- C) Boats may be equipped with electronic positioning or trolling motors.
- D) Electronic and electrical depth finders are allowed.
- E) Communications Devices such as cell phones, pagers, two way radios, marine band radios, etc. are allowed on the boat for emergency use only.

4. Safety

- A) All contestants are required to observe Canadian Rules and regulations concerning safe boating. any team operating a boat in an unsafe fashion will be disqualified at the discretion of the tournament committee. In a second instance of unsafe operation, disqualification will be immediate.
- B) In the event that an unsafe condition arises, i.e. high winds, lightning or an unsafe boat condition the team may go to shore without fear of being disqualified but to avoid disqualification this reported to tournament officials prior to weighing in your fish.
- C) Each entrant must wear a PFD when on plane or moving.

5. Fishing

- A) Only Walleye will be included in official totals.
- B) Only those fish caught on hook and line in a legal manner will be accepted.
- C) Each angler is allowed one (1) line in the water at a time. Spare rods and equipment may be carried in the boat.
- D) All lures, bait and artificial bait must conform to current Saskatchewan Fisheries regulations.
- E) Any walleye mangled, mashed or mauled will be weighed and credited at the discretion of the officials.
- F) Entrants will conduct themselves as true sports persons when fishing near another boat. There is no restricted area around another boat, however no boat may touch another boat. No interference with another angler's line will be allowed.
- G) A contestant must NOT leave the boat to land fish, untangle lines or lures.

- H) The tournament daily limits will be 5 fish per team per day of which only two may be over 21.5".
- All contestants are required to keep fish alive by means of an on board live well system No more than 5 fish will be permitted in the live well at a time Once a fish has been weighed and recorded, no substitutions will be allowed, this rule applies to slot size fish and large fish. Any fish deemed non-releasable will be penalized 20% of the weight of that fish.
- J) No fishing in the Fish Release Area.

6. Tournament Boundaries

A) Fishing will be permitted in the part of Last Mountain Lake bound ed by the following GPS coordinates:

North Boundary East Side - N 51 06.981 W 10514.850 West Side- N 51 06.981 W 10517.700

South Boundary East Side - N 50 51.322 W 10504.650 West Side - N 50 51.322 W 10506.060

7. Weigh In

- A) The scale for weigh in will be open through out the fishing day starting at 10:00 am each day.
- B) Each team will be responsible for their own catch. Under no circumstances may anyone other than the contestants handle or touch a fish until after it has been presented for weigh in.
- C) A team member must accompany the fish to the scales. Each team will receive a copy of their scale ticket each time they weigh in fish. A team member must initial the scale ticket at this time.
- D) At the end of the day a staging area will be in front of the marina entrance where boats will wait until called to enter the marina and weigh fish. No fishing will be allowed in this area.

8. Fish Measurement

- A) All fish will be measured with the tail pinched, belly to belly.
- 9. Fishing Hours and Starting
- A) Start, finish and flight times will be provided at the pre-tournament meeting. In case of a storm, the tournament will be a one-day event (At the discretion of Tournament Committee).
- B) Contestants who return late will have all the fish in their possessions at the time disqualified.
- C) Boats will leave in flights in a shotgun start. The flights will be alternated each day, as well as the numbers inverted. Day 1 Low to High Day 2 High to low.
- D) Contestants must be off the water at 2:00 PM Thursday before the tournament. Registration 4:00 PM and Meeting at 6:00 PM on Thursday.

10. Boat Identification and patrolling

- A) All contestants' boats will be identified with a numbered decal. A team number will be assigned when notified of acceptance into the tournament. Decals will be provided at rules meeting. Place decal on left side of boat.
- B) If an emergency occurs, patrol boats will be available for aid. Patrol boat personnel will be clearly marked for easy identification. All contestants' boats are allowed to dock at headquarters only except as allowed under rule 4, SAFETY.

C) Boats may be inspected before and during the tournament. Tournament officials will be checking boats at the launch area. Patrol boats will be intensively patrolling the fishing areas. Any cheating of any sort will result in immediate disqualification, if protests are upheld.

11. Awards & Prizes

- A) Prizes will be based on most weight (pounds) caught during the tournament.
- B) A prize for the largest live Walleye will be announced for each day.
- C) Prizes will be awarded on a team basis.
- D) In the case of a tie the tie break will go to the person with the highest weight on day 1.
- E) Any angler found to be cheating will be disqualified and prosecuted to the extent permitted bylaw.
- F) All prizes are based on a 165 team field. Tournament Organizers reserve the right to increase entries. Additional monies will go towards the current prize structure. Final prize structure will be announced at the rules meeting.

12. Spirit of the Rule

A) All rules have loopholes. It is the intention of the sponsor to provide an honest sportsman like tournament. In the interest of good sportsmanship, contestants are reminded the spirit of the rule will prevail in all judgments.

13. Protests

- A) Any contestant has the right to make a protest against another contestant. A protest form is available from the tournament chairman and filled out, and presented to the chairman within one hour of close of the fishing day.
- B) A special protest committee will convene for the purpose of determining action. Both parties and possible witnesses may be called before the committee. The committee will meet within three (3) hours of any protest being formally presented
- C) \$150.00 protest fee will be required to accompany any formal protest. The fee is to be returned if the protest is found valid by the Protest committee. If found invalid, the fee will not be refunded. The decision of the protest committee is final in all cases.

11. Miscellaneous

- A) All questions or problems relating to the rules of this tournament are to refer to the tournament committee. Their decision will be final in all cases. No other person can be considered a spokesman for the rules during the tournament.
- B) If one of the two-team members drops out before the tournament, they may be replaced by the choice of the remaining team member. The chairman MUST be notified of the change BEFORE the tournament. NO substitutions allowed after the tournament has started.
- C) If an entire team drops out before the tournament, the place will be filled by the tournament chairman and not the choice of the team that drops out. Entry will be refunded ONLY if notice is given at least 14 days prior to the start of the tournament. NO EXCEPTIONS.

15. Amendments

Any amendments, additions or deletions of these rules will be announced at the pre-tournament rules meeting.

BATTLING BAROTRAUMA DURING CATCH AND RELEASE: AVOID DEEP WATER

Barotrauma is tissue damage caused by a sudden change in pressure. Fish experience the typical atmospheric pressure we are all under, plus the additional pressure of the water on their bodies. The deeper a fish is below the surface, the more water pressure it experiences. When a fish is caught by an angler it is brought to the surface relatively quickly, and experiences a sudden and potentially dramatic reduction in pressure. The consequence is that any gasses in the fish's body expand to reflect the new pressure. This includes changes in the gas volume in the swim bladder, and it may also cause dissolved gasses to come out of solution and expand in a variety of other tissues. Some common symptoms of barotrauma in fish include:

- Bloated belly
- Floating upside down and not able to submerge
- Flared gills
- Bulging eyes
- Stomach protruding into the throat or farther
- Anal swelling / prolapse
- Hemorrhaging or bleeding from a variety of areas
- death

Not all fish are equally susceptible to the full range of barotrauma symptoms. Members of the Salmon and Trout family have a duct connecting the swim bladder and the digestive system, and can rapidly "burp" out gasses as they are being retrieved. The scientific term for this type of fish is physostomous; northern pike also belong to this category. These fish experience fewer issues with the swim bladder and excess buoyancy, but may still suffer other types of tissue damage. Members of the Perch family such as walleye, sauger, and yellow perch do not have the duct connecting the swim bladder and the digestive tract and cannot rapidly release gas during retrieval. These species are categorized as physoclistous; burbot are also in this category. Here are some important barotrauma facts, mostly based on scientific studies of physoclistous species like walleye:

 Mild barotrauma symptoms may begin as shallow as 4.5m (15 ft); symptoms get worse with increasing depth.

- At 9.1m (30 ft) depth the pressure is double that at the surface; physoclistous fish (e.g., walleye) caught at this depth or deeper may experience severe barotrauma.
- Fishing in shallow water next to a deep drop off may produce some fish with unexpected barotrauma.
- Barotrauma symptoms are exacerbated when fish are held at the surface; holding fish in a live well generally makes barotrauma worse.
- Slow retrieval does not alleviate barotrauma; the diffusion of gas from the swim bladder and other tissues takes hours or longer.
- The only way to systematically reduced barotrauma in walleye is to avoid fishing in deep water.

The Saskatchewan Sportfish Research Group has been conducting research on barotrauma in tournament-caught walleye for a number of years. A continuing partnership with the Last Mountain Fall Wall-

eye Classic has made a large portion of this work possible, and we are always grateful to the organizers and the anglers for working with us. We have been studying barotrauma in a number of different ways: (a) assessment of symptoms in fish in-hand; (b) tracking of fish after release using acoustic telemetry; and (c) long-term tagging programs that examine recapture frequency of tagged fish. One of the key questions for both anglers and fisheries managers is whether or not treatment of barotrauma in walleve is effective. There are two major types of treatment: (1) venting or "fizzing" of the swim bladder with a hypodermic needle to let out excess gas volume; and (2) descending the fish back to capture depth with a temporarily attached weighted device. Both of these techniques have potential pros and cons, but the bottom line is that there simply isn't enough good data out there to make well-informed decisions yet. However, we have been hard at work doing research and there are some key take-away points for walleye compiled from years of data collection.

- Barotrauma is by far the most common cause of impairment of fish at traditional weigh-in walleye tournaments in Saskatchewan.
- Stress, including high water temperature and fatigue, exacerbates barotrauma symptoms.
- Fish with severe barotrauma that are released and float at the surface have very high mortality rates.
- Fin weights do not alleviate moderate to severe barotrauma symptoms.
- Fizzing changes the depths and areas of the lake used by walleye in the days after release.
- Fish that are descended back to capture depth behave more normally in the days after release.

 Tagged fish with barotrauma that are fizzed are substantially less likely to be recaptured.

Ultimately, our research has revealed that barotrauma is a substantial issue for both fish in traditional tournaments, as well as in other forms of recreational angling. There is still much work to be done. At this point we can say with confidence that treatments like fizzing do save some that for walleye or other physoclistous species. But some additional thought may be required to adapt to specific situations. For example, if you're fishing Fox's Point on Last Mountain Lake, the depth may shift from 30 feet to 60 feet in just a few boat lengths. Fish rushing up from deeper water to smash your bait may have severe barotrauma even though they were technically caught at 30

fish; however, long-term tagging results suggest that a high proportion of treated fish don't make it. Consequently, barotrauma treatment of fish should be viewed as a last resort for unexpected cases, and not as a mainstream strategy for catch and release angling. Our goal as anglers and fish enthusiasts should be to eliminate as much barotrauma as possible, and the focus must therefore be on avoiding deep water. How deep? In general, 30 feet is used as the cut-off point – anglers should definitely not be fishing deeper than

feet. Normally the depth change to catch prey would not be an issue for them, they would simply swim back down and return to pressure equilibrium. If they are caught, they don't have the ability to self-correct the pressure difference, which leads to barotrauma symptoms. Lets do our best to make sure the fish we catch and release are happy and healthy at the end of the day.
